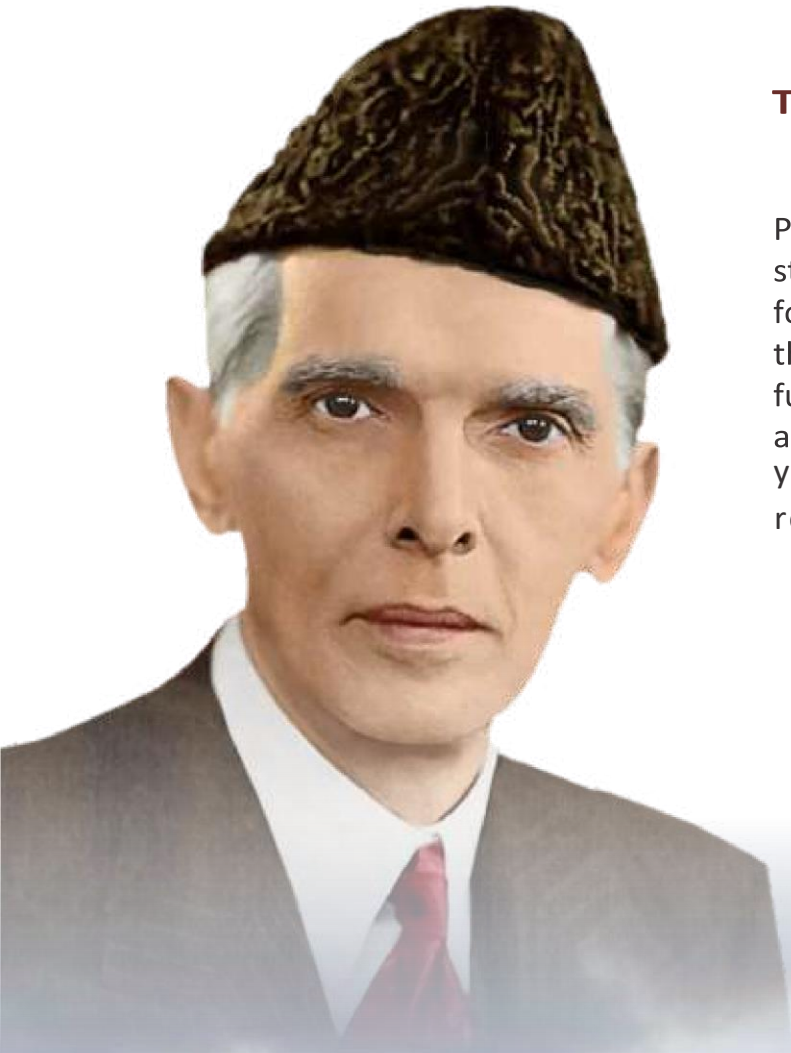

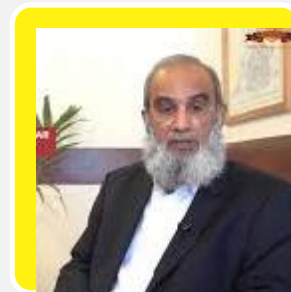

A BRIEF INTRODUCTION TO THE HUB CADET COLLEGE (THCC)

The Hub Cadet College (THCC) is spread over 240 acres with all facilities that a cadet college should provide for its cadets. It is a residential institution, offering a wide range of curricular and co-curricular activities. The curriculum is so designed as to cater for the educational needs of both beginners and middle-adolescents. The standard of teaching, learning and assessment is in line with the international benchmark. Besides excellence in 'cognitive' domain, the College also gives due importance to the 'affective' and 'psychomotor' domains of the educational objectives. Therefore, THCC ensures availability of resources for cadets to participate in co-curricular activities and sports. We create a conducive environment for positive, substantial change in its beneficiaries

WHY 'THE HUB CADET COLLEGE'

THCC forms a concrete basis in students' training and education by virtue of which, on average, they achieve greater success in their careers than the graduates through ordinary schooling. For example, a cadet is exempted from the two preliminary test before ISSB Exam, while joining armed forces to become a commissioned officer. With their grooming and the skill of public speaking, cadets easily pass their interviews for higher education, competitive examinations and career opportunities

Moreover, at THCC, a desired balance between academic excellence and 'rectitude' is struck for the success of our students, both here and the hereafter.

The whole purpose of founding a cadet college is produce visionary leaders to serve the nation, in all professional domains, with honesty, loyalty, competency, and commitment to a noble cause.



ASSESSMENT BOARDS

The Hub Cadet College is affiliated with two Assessment Boards:

1. IGCSE, CAMBRIDGE

International General Certificate of Secondary Education is under Cambridge Assessment of International Education (CAIE). Cadets are prepared to sit IGCSE examinations. The school follows Cambridge curriculum for the International Assessment Board. Its curriculum takes students to a high pedestal of multifarious learning, critical thinking, and creativity.

2. FBISE, ISLAMABAD

Federal Board of Intermediate and Secondary Education, Islamabad is another international assessment board. There are many overseas schools affiliated with FBISE. Cadets of 'The Hub Cadet College' have an option to appear for matriculation examination.

This option is an advantage for those 'overseas students' who want to continue their studies under FBISE after getting admission or transfer to our institution. It is equally advantageous for those cadets of THCC, who want to continue their education in any Province of Pakistan or in any of the 42 overseas schools in Asia. For FBISE exams, students have to follow the National Curriculum of Pakistan.

INFRA-STRUCTURE AND FACILITIES

In conformity with international standards, 'The Hub Cadet College' has cutting-edge facilities. THCC has two big multi-storied hostels, two academic block inclusive of staff rooms and separate offices for teachers, laboratory block (having well-equipped, capacious laboratories, and a voluminous library, an administrative block (inclusive of a 24-hour operating sick bay with an experienced doctor and a paramedical staff), a well-planned mess hall, playgrounds, a gym, a beautiful mosque, cafeteria, stable, poultry farm, vegetable farm, cattle farm, a wide stretch of orchards, houses for all staff, official vehicles including tractors and a dedicated ambulance, guardrooms, a substation, a huge solar energy system for diurnal supply of electricity, and a swimming pool. Facilities also include laundry, barber's room, ironing room and a tuck shop.

LIFE AT 'THE HUB CADET COLLEGE' (THCC)

The day in THCC starts with 'Reveille' and ends with 'Light out'. Cadets are given time to get ready for Fajar prayers, followed by Morning PT/Parade in their uniforms. They go back to their Hostel for shower and change.

In winter, cadets use hot water conducted from geysers. After breakfast in Mess Hall, cadets march in formation towards academic block for assembly, preceding their formal education in classes and labs.

Chemistry, Physics, Biology, Computer and English lessons take place in their commodious laboratories. Other subjects are taught in classrooms. In Break, cadets are given refreshment in Mess. Cafeteria also serves cadets. After classes are over, cadets move to Mess for lunch, which is followed by change of dress for Zuhur Prayers.

Cadets, then, relax and enjoy siesta followed by events, like Asar Prayers, Sports hour, Maghrib Prayers, Prep-1, Dinner, Canteen hour, Isha Prayers and Prep-2. A master on duty observes and reports on these routine events. Preps are the preparatory hours in which cadets study in their rooms, duly supervised by their house staff and guided by the concerned subject teachers as per their schedule. In the last 15 minutes of the daily routine, students have to prepare their kit for the next day. Saturday evenings bring change in cadets' mundane routine with an entertaining movie-show; minus preps. Sundays bring parents to the campus, which refurbishes the lost spirits of cadets.

They are also allowed to call their parents on Sundays. A glorious Sunday is not yet over, when they are served a sumptuous dinner at Mess.

There is a spectrum of colourful events like picnics, educational trips, bonfire, club activities, inter house sports, computer, etc., in their annual calendar sporadically taking place throughout the year, adding colour to the life of a cadet in The Hub Cadet College.

CHARACTER-BUILDING

The Hub Cadet College emphasizes moral edifice and rectitude. Besides teachers, the qualified Imam of the Mosque lends some time to advising cadets on moral values after prayers, telling cadets solutions to their personal issues, in the light of the Quran and Sunnah. Teachers act as role-model for cadets. There is no compromise on bullying or any such immoral acts; therefore, no side-effect of hostel life exists in our cadet college, by the Grace of God.

RULES & REGULATIONS

GENERAL RULES

1. Cadets are not permitted to keep the following in the Hostel: TV set, Transistors, Video Games, Electric appliances, Personal Computer / Lap Top, Wireless Radio, Radio, Walkman set, Mobile Telephone, Cameras of any type, and such other devices.
2. A boy may have a single cell phone to be handed over, upon reporting after leave or vacation, to the House Master for safe-keeping. Possession of additional mobile phones is forbidden. A Mobile phone should be of the simplest type as explained in Mobile Phone Policy of THCC.
3. Cadets are not allowed to keep with them any contraband items inclusive of, and not limited to, drugs, arms and weapons, cigarettes, narcotics in any form, matchbox, firearms, knife of any kind, burner, heater, indecent pictures or literature, explosive or combustible material, and musical instruments.

4. Cadets have to report back at College from home after term break or vacation or granted leave on the scheduled date of return. Late-arrival shall lead to penalty, including revocation of the concession in fees, already allowed. In case of emergency, Principal must be contacted well before the reporting time.
5. Cadets have to follow all School policies regarding mobile fan, travel, visitor authorization, picnic, dress code, personal hygiene upkeep, sleeping habits, use of College resources and all general principles based on morality.
6. Vandalism is strictly discouraged on the premises of THCC. Cadets found guilty of breaking or damaging College property are punished.
7. Cadets bunking from class, laboratory, library or any such learning area inclusive of scheduled events shall result in heavy fine and/or other suitable punishment.
8. Cadets using intoxicants, drugs or cigarettes of any kind may be instantly struck off the College Roll.
9. Cheating, lying, stealing, gambling and immoral conduct shall be dealt with strictly.
10. Breaking the College bounds shall lead to the expulsion of the cadet from THCC.
11. The rude behaviour of the cadet's parents with the school staff shall lead to the expulsion of the cadet.
12. The management of THCC takes all possible steps to secure life and health of cadets. However, if by destiny a cadet meets fatal injury, THCC management will not be held responsible.
13. Parents may give pocket money for their sons to the housemasters, which cadets can get as per their need from time to time. No boy may keep sum of money in his possession, or receive sum of money for safe-keeping from whatever the source.
14. No boy is allowed to bring MP3, 4.5, or electronic diary or smart/android phones or any such gadgets. If any of these items found in his possession, it will be confiscated by the College.
15. Medical / dental appointments should preferably be planned for School holidays, as no leave of absence from College, whatsoever, is granted in the last two week of any term.
16. No leave will be granted to attend a wedding ceremony unless it is that of real brother or sister. Leave will be granted only for a weekend; and, only in case an application in advance is given along with a printed invitation.

MOBILE PHONE POLICY

If a cadet wants to bring a mobile phone to the hostel, he may do so on the following conditions:

- a. Only one mobile phone may be brought.
- b. It must be kept in the custody of the concerned House Master.
- c. It is to be used only on Sundays.
- d. It must be of the simplest type – it should have no camera, module memory or module games.
- e. THCC shall not be held responsible for its loss or damage while in the possession of the student.
- f. Any breach of the above regulation will result in the loss of this privilege.
- g. Infringement of any of the above conditions will be regarded as a serious breach of College Discipline; and, it may result in the suspension or expulsion of the cadet.

Field Trip Permission
